15	1. That § 18.2-361 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
16	§ 18.2-361. Crimes Against Nature
17	A. If any person carnally knows in any manner any brute animal, or carnally
18	knows any male or female person by the anus or by or with the mouth, or voluntarily
19	submits to such carnal knowledge, he or she shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony,
20	except as provided in subsection B.
21	B. Any person who carnally knows by the anus or by or with the mouth his
22	daughter or granddaughter, son or grandson, brother or sister, or father or mother
23	shall be guilty of a Class 5 felony. However, if a parent or grandparent commits any
