14	Be it enacted by the YMCA Model General Assembly:
15	1. That § 19.2-264.2 of the Code of Virginia is eliminated as follows:
16	§ 19.2-264.2. Conditions for imposition of death sentence
17	In assessing the penalty of any person convicted of an offense for which the death
18	penalty may be imposed, a sentence of death shall not be imposed unless the court
19	or jury shall (1) after consideration of the past criminal record of convictions of
20	the defendant, find that there is a probability that the defendant would commit
21	criminal acts of violence that would constitute a continuing serious threat to
22	society or that his conduct in committing the offense for which he stands charged
23	was outrageously or wantonly vile, horrible or inhuman in that it involved torture,
24	depravity of mind or an aggravated battery to the victim; and (2) recommend that
25	the penalty of death be imposed.
