12	Be it enacted by the YMCA Model General Assembly:
13	1. That § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
14	§ 63.2-505.2. Eligibility for food stamps; drug related felonies.
15	A person who is otherwise eligible to receive food stamp benefits shall be exempt from
16	the application of section 115(a) of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity
17	Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely
18	because he has been convicted of a felony offense of possession of a controlled substance
19	in violation of § 18.2-250, provided such person is complying with, or has already
20	complied with, all obligations imposed by the criminal court, is actively engaged in or
21	has completed a substance abuse treatment program, participates in periodic drug
22	screenings, and any other obligations as determined by the Department.
